



SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Brunner Gallery exhibits two and three dimensional contemporary fine and functional artwork. Submissions to the gallery are reviewed quarterly. Brunner gallery welcomes a preliminary digital submission. Should the gallery wish to see a more complete portfolio presentation, you will be asked to mail or hand-carry a more complete portfolio to the gallery, or the curator may request an interview as part of the presentation process. **Please note** that Brunner Gallery is a fine arts gallery and requests professional submissions, including good digital images, for the preliminary review which means that the image is free of background clutter, well-lighted with color and texture accurately represented. All decisions for representation are made by committee.

The following information should be part of your submission:

Professional Resume: Education and Training
Professional Experience in the arts (exhibitions included)
Awards and Honors/Fellowships
Collections
Publications and Reviews

Documentation:

Preliminary Review: 3 image files no larger than 72 dpi jpeg file format for easy transmission to curator@brunnergallery.com. Information such as title, date, medium, and dimensions is required. Please submit a professional resume or curriculum vitae with a preliminary submission.

Secondary Review: Disc with at least 20 images of recent work created within the last two years. The images should be 72 or 300 dpi, 5 x 7 print size, jpeg format preferred. Ten of the images should be of work that is currently available. 3-dimensional artwork should include two views of each piece. Artworks created under direct supervision are not eligible. No student work please. Any materials mailed and delivered to the gallery for the secondary review should include a stamped self addressed envelope for return. In addition to a professional resume or curriculum vitae, we request the following for a second review:

Biography and statement:

This includes the artist's general background information (who, what, where, when and why) and a more formal statement about the artist's most recent artwork.

Retail Price Range:

Brunner Gallery considers professional artwork that is available in a variety of mediums, sizes and price ranges. In order for us to offer representation to an artist, it is necessary for us to consider whether the artist will be a good fit for the private and corporate collectors who make up our client base. **We request that each image include not only the title, dimensions and medium, but also the retail price range.**
